UNCONDITIONAL LOVE

John 3:16 says, ***"For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son so that anyone who believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."***

Strong's Concordance says that the Greek word for love used here is unconditional love: love by choice and by an act of the will. Agape' is the word for God's unconditional love. According to

Romans 5:5 this God-Kind-Of-Love belongs to every believer.

"And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us." (KJV) Or as the New King James version says, ***"Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us."***

Agape' denotes an undefeatable benevolence and unconquerable goodwill that always seeks the highest good for the other person, no matter what he does. It is self-giving love that gives freely without asking anything in return and does not consider the worth of its object. Agape' love refers to the will rather than the emotions. Agape' describes the unconditional love God has for us.

OUR EXAMPLE

God the Father and Jesus are our examples of what love is and what love does. Jesus gave His life voluntarily. No man took it from Him. Man did not kill Jesus. John 19:30 says, ***"... He said, 'It is finished!' And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit."*** (NKJV) Matthew 27:50 says he yielded up His spirit. This means it was a voluntary act. I can guarantee you Jesus did not **feel** like

dying for our sins. He chose to die. Love is a decision, an act of our wills, a choice.

Jesus is our example for choosing to walk in love. Why did He choose to die for our sins and how could He do this? Hebrews 12:2-4 says, **"Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls."**

"For the joy that was set before Him," Jesus endured the cross. He knew that we would one day trust in His blood for our salvation and that gave Him great joy. However, He despised the shame of hanging on that cross. Likewise, we do not like the shame and embarrassment of separation and divorce. However, we can endure it because we know that God was a witness to the covenant made at our marriage vows and He will heal our marriages. Knowing this gives us great joy, also.

John 15:13 says, **"Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends."** (NKJV) What better way to lay down our lives for our mates than to choose (make a decision as an act of our wills) to love them unconditionally by remaining true to our marriage covenants?



Is it possible for us to lay down our lives for our marriages, our homes, our families? At first it seems impossible; and to our carnal nature it is. However, we have the love of God shed abroad in our hearts and the grace of God that makes it possible.

According to Galatians 5:22 the fruit of the Spirit is **love**, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, and self control. This fruit of the Spirit is within us. Our spirits were recreated and born again when we received Jesus as our Savior, so love is there. We just have to be willing to allow it to flow through us to our mates and others.

***What better way to lay down
our lives for our mates than to
love them unconditionally.***

Phil 2:8-9 says, **"And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God**

also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name." Jesus is our example. By humbling Himself He was exalted. By humbling ourselves and laying down our lives in prayer for our mates, we too shall be exalted.

WE ARE BRIDGES

Some will tell us we are in error and others will tell us we are being doormats; that we are just letting our mates walk all over us.

When we lay down our lives for our mates **we become a bridge** for them to walk over to Christ, either for salvation or restoration. According to John 10:9 Christ is the door they need to walk through. What a wonderful privilege to become a bridge by laying down our lives for our mates and standing for our marriages.

Choosing to lay down one's life means death to selfishness: **MY** plans, **MY** desires, whatever makes **ME** feel good or makes **ME** happy.

Say this out loud: "Love is a decision. Laying down my life is a decision. It is a choice and not a feeling. I choose to love regardless of my feelings, knowing that as I am obedient to God, His grace will see me through."

In conclusion, the words of Don Francisco's song **Love Is Not A Feeling** are especially meaningful to those of us who are standing for our marriages.

**Now I wouldn't try to tell you
That it's easy to stand,
Satan's throwing everything
That's at his command.
But Jesus is faithful,
His promise is true,
And the things that He asks
He gives the power to do.
Jesus didn't die for you
Because it was fun,
He hung there for love
Because it had to be done.
And in spite of the anguish
His Word was fulfilled,
Cause love is not a feeling,
It's an act of your will.**

GOD IS GOOD

When one considers the goodness of God, almost every believer would attest that God's goodness is universal and consistent. But an interesting and yet relatively unknown truth underpins the goodness of God. That truth is this; all deception begins by questioning the goodness of God.

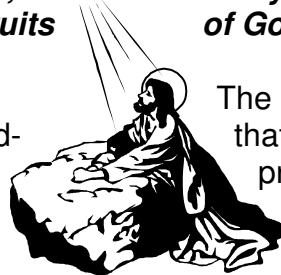
James 1:16-18 says, "***Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren. Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow. In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the word of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.***" NASU

Do not be deceived; the Apostle admonishes us. Deception is the sin that causes all sins. In the Garden of Eden, Eve was deceived by the devil. She lived in a perfect environment with a sinless husband and a God who walked with her in the cool of the day. She had not been abused as a child, her parents were not alcoholics, she was not picked on in high school, and she was not inundated with perverted media. She was loved by God and her husband. Yet she was deceived by the devil. The fact of the matter is she looked outside of God's provision to fulfill her desires. We are in deception any time we look outside of the goodness of God for our needs to be met.

James warns us not to be deceived. Deception is linked to believing that there is good outside of God's provision. "***Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above.***" To assume you can do good apart from the will of God is to be deceived. This is why it is sin for believers to "help" God with the strength of the flesh, or by intricately designed plans to ma-

nipulate their spouses to action or to an awakening. It does not work. Consider Jesus while he was being tempted in the desert by the devil.

In Matthew 4:1 we read: "***Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And after He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He then became hungry. And the tempter came and said to Him, 'If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.'*** But He answered and said, '*It is written, man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.*'" NASU



The devil tempted Jesus to provide for himself that which the Father promised He would provide. "Use your authority and power to provide for yourself. How can you say God loves you if you are suffering? He has given you a brain and authority; He would want you to live. You will die and the kingdom will be lost if you do not intervene now. Surely God does not want you to die like this. Command the stone to become bread. After all, God helps those who help themselves," the devil might have proclaimed.

The issue of this temptation is to bring into doubt the very nature and character of God. For Jesus to eat is not sin. To turn stone into bread is not sin. In fact, that is a pretty cool miracle. The sin comes at the point where the goodness of God is brought into question and a provision is made in the flesh. When one does not believe God will take care of the situation, sin follows. That is why James argues that all good is from God and that goodness has "***no variation or shifting shadow.***" God is consistent in His goodness and it is impossible for Him to be anything else.

Therefore one can have full confidence that God has your best interest in mind. He will answer your prayers, orchestrate redemption, move on your behalf, and secure your future.

The key is for our hearts to become sensitive to the point where our trust is in God's goodness, not the strength of the flesh. Mathew 6:25-33 states in part: ***"For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? ...And who of you by being worried can add a single hour to his life? ...Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat? or What will we drink? or 'What will we wear for clothing?' ...For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."*** NASU

To make this more appropriate to Covenant Keepers, a rendering could be as follows: "Do not worry about your spouse and what they are doing. I will take care of your needs and supply all the grace necessary for your healing. If I care about birds and flowers, will I not care about you? And who of you by being worried can add a single hour to his life? Do not be eaten up by fear but rather trust in my goodness and have confidence in My love for you. Do not get lost in what they are doing and who they are seeing, fear kills faith. But seek first My kingdom and My righteousness, and all these issues will be dealt with."

As Covenant Keepers we need to hold on to the goodness of God. He is good and He is God, therefore I can believe. I do not need to

make a provision for myself. God is good. I do not need to be anxious concerning the future. God is good. I do not need to strive for my marriage. God is good. I need not concern myself with the details of sin. God is good. I can have confidence in my future. God is good. I can believe for my healing. God is good. I can be assured of my restoration. God is good. My needs are met. God is good. I am blessed because **GOD IS GOOD.**

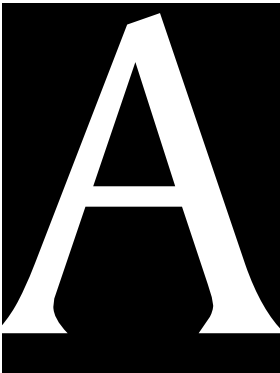

A TRIBUTE

year ago our Covenant Keeper's group decided to do a ten day Daniel Fast (from the bible; eating only vegetables) in order to hear more clearly from the Lord for direction and guidance for ourselves, our group and our Region. We began the first of January.

We were into the fast 3 days when my dad called me saying he wasn't feeling well. I told him I had just put in a time off request from my job for the end of January and my sister and I were going to Florida to see him. He said, "Super," his favorite phrase.

The next morning my sister called me at work saying Dad was in the hospital being checked for blockage but it wasn't serious and she, being a nurse, was going to fly down to make sure he was okay. I became very upset in my spirit and had to leave work. I cried all the way home. The Holy Spirit was preparing me.

My sister called from Florida saying Dad had a massive heart attack and it didn't look good. I immediately went on a total fast, led by the Lord and called all our intercessors and prayer warriors. My other sister and I got tickets for the next flight. My prayer burden for my dad was so intense I prayed and read the Word for hours before our flight. On the plane I prayed quietly and the burden would not lift. We got stuck in another airport, since it was not a direct flight, and I could not eat or drink. I was in a God anointed fast. Finally in the air the burden lifted and I had the greatest peace. When we arrived at my dad's house my sister told us Dad had died at 6:00 pm, the time the peace flooded my heart.

I am a child of divorce and as a little girl I had a burden for marriage and family. I prayed to the Lord to make my parents stop fighting and get along. I never wanted them to divorce as we were a family with six children.

My Dad left my mom for another woman. My mother fell apart, getting deeper into alcohol. When she almost died we got her into rehab. She was sober a short time when my sister was killed in a car accident at 28. My mom hoped my dad would return after this but he had gotten into another affair and the divorce went through. My mom was completely devastated but she had a spiritual awakening and her faith sustained her. She remained sober for 20 years before her death and became the woman God intended her to be.

The woman my dad got involved with had a very greedy, hateful spirit toward us children and from day one we were the enemy for the inheritance. She never accepted us; she tolerated us. Everything we did she would turn around to make us look bad. It took me a long time to forgive her. It was a constant

70X7 struggle. I finally came to realize I was not fighting flesh and blood and that made it easier to forgive.

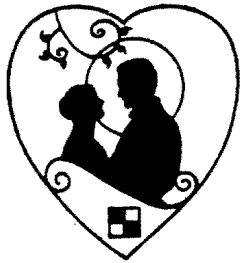
When my mom heard my husband left me she said "Nancy, don't you do what I did. I only married once for better or worse, richer or poorer, in sickness and health, till death do we part; but I don't want him back. He will always be my husband but I couldn't live with him again." I told her of my stand and she said there is someone else out there for me. I couldn't make her see what I was doing. However, she remained faithful to her vows until her death. My dad was so upset when she took ill. He flew up from Florida alone and was with us when she passed away. He was the first one at the funeral parlor, seated all alone before her casket, when we arrived. He called me after he got home and said the biggest mistake of his life was to leave our mom. He truly was sorry.

When my Dad died we were concerned that his legal wife would not give us his body. We wanted to give him a Christian Mass and burial. This is where I believe the fast I was on gave me such boldness and power over the spirit in her. She finally agreed but said we were on our own. We brought him home where our family and friends had a wonderful service for him. He is buried in the cemetery next to my mom, my brother and my sister.

After a few days I went to visit my dad's best friend. During the visit he told me when my dad was up the previous Fall he told him he was sick of Florida and missed us kids, grandkids and great-grandkids and that he was going to come home and buy a condo to be near us. He is home now and my mom's commitment to her vows had a great reward and so will mine. Thank the Lord for generations to come.

Saskatchewan: CK had a good conversation with spouse after months of silence.

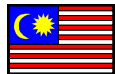
For the first time in nine years, CK and husband are going away for their anniversary.

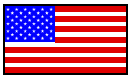
Palmerston North: CK conference increased CK's faith despite not being able to logically understand everything. He is finding the curriculum, "Principles for Marriage Healing" studies very good.

TURN DISCONTENT TO CONTENTMENT

"...for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content...I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Philippians 4:11-13 NKJV

"Now is the winter of our discontent made glorious summer...."

William Shakespeare, King Richard III

Weighed down by discouragement, seemingly living in a gray, gloomy winterscape with no end in sight, some covenant keepers seemingly cannot hope for even the slightest glimpse of summer sunshine. For them, the idea of turning discontent into contentment seems about as far-fetched as the goal of medieval alchemists to turn lead into gold. Not too long ago one man standing for the healing of his marriage said to another covenant keeper who had achieved a level of contentment after his wife divorced him, "Man, I don't see how you can do it. You must be a better man than I am."

Was this discontented covenant keeper truly a worse man? For him, divorce and separation were so devastating that overcoming his grief seemed like an impossible dream. Paul encourages us to be content no matter what the circumstances. Does Paul mean that someone who is hurt, lonely and who feels like a limb was ripped off can turn the base element of discontent into the precious metal of contentment?

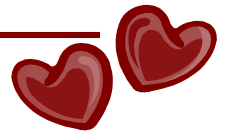
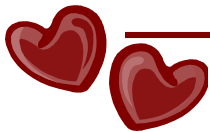
If anyone had a reason to be discontent and discouraged it was Paul. Blinded, betrayed, persecuted, shipwrecked and imprisoned, he still learned to be content despite overwhelmingly difficult circumstances. Like the servant of Elisha who saw God's armies ready to do battle against what looked like an invincible enemy, Paul saw God's provision beyond and behind the circumstances.

Present day chemists apply heat, pressure or other forces to break apart the bonds holding certain molecules together, then reassemble the resulting into compounds designed to be useful and productive. In God's laboratory, He oversees as elements (us) undergo heat and pressure (circumstances), and He manages the process to create something new and better for His service. "All things work together for good to them who love God, and are called according to His purpose." Romans 8:28

DISCONTENT: a sense of grievance, dissatisfaction, resentment, unhappiness

CONTENTED: feeling or manifesting satisfaction with one's possessions, status, or situation.
